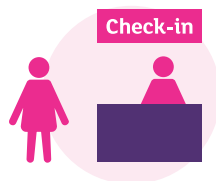

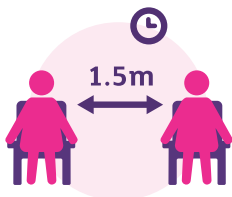
The changes we've made:

Providing hand sanitiser

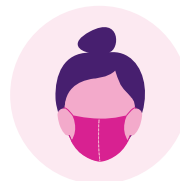


Ongoing cleaning of equipment and commonly used surfaces



Precautionary questions around health and travel

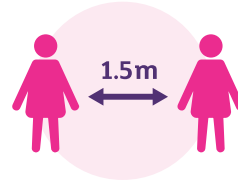
To prepare for your appointment:
